## Special Committee re. SJC & IRPC ... Report to 2023 Synod

- 2 Dear brothers by the grace of adoption into the family of our Lord, Jesus Christ:
- 3 Your Committee was given this task: "... to facilitate a meeting between members of the
- 4 SJC & the IRPC in the pursuit of the peace, purity, and unity of the church."
- 5 After extensive discussion, the Committee decided to proceed with the assumption that
- 6 remit allowed for only a single meeting. With this in mind, the Committee attempted to
- 7 make arrangements for the meeting within a month of the Synod meeting, but the
- 8 difficulty of logistics made such arrangements impossible. The plan, then, targeted a
- 9 meeting date in late September, 2022.
- 10 Through consultation with various parties and counselors, two particular concerns for
- such a meeting became evident: (1) There was much concern that a large-format meeting
- dealing with such difficult matters would get out of hand, resulting in more offense and
- creating yet another barrier to reconciliation between the Immanuel congregation and the
- other parties. (2) Both the representatives of the [SJC] Commission and the members of
- the [IRPC] congregation were agreed on their fears that such a meeting would become a
- re-trial of the case, again creating more confusion and offense.
- 17 To address the first concern, the meeting was constructed to constrain the number of
- interactions by involving a discussion between the (local) members of the IRPC Session
- 19 and representatives of the Commission, with the Committee setting the frame for the
- 20 discussion and the moderator of Synod presiding over the meeting. In the event, the active
- 21 individuals in the meeting were, then, the three locally elected members of the Immanuel
- 22 Session, one member of the Commission, an alternant of the commission, and the legal
- counsel for the Commission, your Committee, and the Moderator of the 2022 Synod.
- 24 The congregation was in attendance.
- 25 In order to allow for input into the discussion from the congregation, an intermission
- 26 was set in the center of the meeting, during which the congregation met with the
- 27 Immanuel Session to request focus on particular topics and additional questions for
- 28 the latter half of the meeting.
- 29 To address the second concern, the content of the meeting's discussion was structured
- 30 around specific questions from the Session to the representatives of the Commission.
- 31 Questions were solicited from the congregation, and then were filtered to remove
- 32 questions centering on the content of the trial itself, then were compiled & compressed.
- An open call for questions was sent to the Congregation, and 69 questions were received,
- 34 which were compiled into nineteen questions, from which seven questions were selected
- 35 by the Session and forwarded through the Committee to the representatives of the Session
- 36 prior to the meeting.

- 1 The meeting was held on the 19<sup>th</sup> of September, from 7-9 p.m. at the Immanuel church
- 2 building. The agenda for the meeting is below. The conversations of the evening were
- 3 substantive, thoughtful and cordial, though, understandably, did not fully encompass
- 4 the range of questions, and were largely inconclusive. Following the meeting the
- 5 representatives of the Commission and the Committee and Moderator remained
- 6 having largely cordial and helpful conversations with members of the Immanuel
- 7 congregation, leaving around 10 p.m.
